



CIBC US Digital Banking: Reset your password

Resetting your password is easy and convenient as a self-service option in CIBC Bank USA's digital banking tools.

- 1 From the CIBC US Digital Banking login, and select Reset password

- 2 Enter your User ID
Select which form of identification verification you want to provide (social security number)
Click Continue

- 3 Select your contact method from the drop down menu
Click Send verification code
Retrieve the verification code and finalize verification

- 4 1. Enter your new password using the following criteria:

Length: 8 to 32 characters

Must include at least three of the following four:

- Lowercase letter
- Uppercase letter
- Number
- Symbol (note: some symbols are restricted)

No more than two sequential numbers or letters in a row

2. Enter the new password in the Confirm your new password field
3. Click Continue

To maintain the security of your account, you'll need to choose a new password.

- ✓ Between 8 and 32 characters
- ✓ At least 3 of the following: lowercase letter, uppercase letter, number, symbol (@#&'&*~)_(+=|/?;:-)
- ✓ No other symbols, no restricted combinations or words, and no more than 2 identical or sequential characters in a row

For a stronger password, aim for 16 characters or more.
